International Youth Internship Program

CRWRF is excited to launch the support for a new internship program. This program is offered in partnership with CRWRC through their Service Learning Program. This internship is a 2-year position that will offer an “apprentice” type of experience in Christian Community Development at a grassroots level. Interns will assist local partner organizations and churches in carrying out effective and appropriate community level projects in a variety of areas: agriculture, income generation, health, education and literacy. All of this work is done through collaboration with indigenous groups. In the first year, the intern will be under the supervision and mentorship of a Program Consultant in the field and in the second year, will put into practice the skills learned directly towards the development of the project.

The applicant for Internship will need to be a committed Christian who is active in their church and local community, good at relationship building, eager to learn and serve others in humility and able to invite others to form with them a network of prayer and support. They must have at least a college diploma, although a Bachelor's degree in any discipline is preferred, as well as 6 months of overseas experience (at least 4mths concurrent).

The Intern will be provided with SPLICE mission prep in Canada, language and culture training (3mths on field), field supervisor and mentor, on field training in Results Based Management, training and assistance in raising support, career counseling, debriefing and possible deferment of student loans (if applicable).

The financial support for the intern will be largely covered by a grant from the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) as well as support from CRWRF.
